This email's headline is no more surprising to you than to me - yes, I'm back in Africa!



Unfortunately, this time without the Granny, as this is a bit of a business trip. I'm in Egypt as part of a TV show called "Reel Outdoors". We will be fly fishing for Nile Perch. This fish could be one of the toughest I've attempted with the fly yet because they get up to 200lbs!!!!!!!!!!!! And of course, there's been some terrorism issues in Egypt as of late.

I left Victor at 3 am Friday the 5th and drove to SLC airport and met up with "Reel Outdoors" host Chris Bailey. You may remember, I did a show in Namibia Africa on Zambezi River for Tigerfish with Chris last Nov.
