Currier and Jones in Ririe Bass Tournament



Jeff Currier and Weldon Jones participated in the first ever "Fly Fishing Only" smallmouth bass tournament on Ririe Reservoir in Ririe, Idaho. The tournament was organized by Kevin Brazell of the Wyoming Bass Federation and was comprised of eleven two man teams. Rules were limited to a 12 horsepower max on boat engines and only one angler casting at a time. Each team

could enter their best five fish over 12 inches. All fish were to be kept in an aerated cooler for the weigh in at the end of the day.

Despite being the first boat in the water, Currier's team suffered a bum motor thus getting off to a slow start. Due to the mechanical problems the team became an underdog next to other, newer boats with nicer motors; little did they know that the quality of boat means nothing when it comes to catching bass!

Jeff and Weldon took home the 3rd place trophies with their five smallies weighing in at 5.35lbs!
